Letter of the Week

This week we learned the letter R with the story of Racing Raccoon. We made a rocket wheel of R words and learned the poem, "Rabbit by a River". We made many more pairs of rhyming words and made "ing" and "old" word families. We will make short books on "Little Jack Horner" and "Hey Diddle Diddle" this week.
