Important Updates

Here is a detailed schedule for the end-of-the-year activities:

Thursday, May 26 - All day field trip to the Milwaukee County Zoo and Willowood Park. If you are meeting us at the zoo we will meet you at the entrance at 9:00. If you are meeting us at Willowood Park (W151 N5476 Badger Drive, 53051 - near the intersection of Silver Spring & Pilgrim) we should be there by 11:45. Each child should bring a bag lunch and drink. The animal show will begin at 1:20 and will return to school for pick-up at 3:00. If you are taking your child home from Willowood, please sign out with me.
